We are passionate about herbalism and especially about educating our students. Picking a school to learn from is an important decision. How does learning at the Herbal Academy work?

The basics...

All of our courses are offered online. For students who wish to learn outside of an online platform, we do offer printed course textbooks for both the Introductory and Intermediate Herbal Courses. Students who wish to study online and from the course textbooks will receive a student discount on the course textbooks, however these are completely optional for students joining us online. Note that downloadable PDF printouts of all course material are available with online course enrollment.

Most of the content in our courses is presented in written format. Topical videos (with downloadable transcripts), helpful graphics, and beautiful images are interspersed throughout most of our courses.

Once you have enrolled in an online course with us, you will immediately have access to your course materials via a Student Dashboard that is created uniquely for you during registration. You will log in to your Student Dashboard to access your courses and navigate through your studies. Course access time does not begin until you click the Start Course button. There is a separate Start Course button for each course you have registered for—these are found in your Student Dashboard.

Course content is arranged into units of study, each containing several lessons. A downloadable PDF of each unit's content is available upon accessing that unit. Students taking foundational courses must pass a quiz at the end of each unit with a score of 80% or higher to access the next unit. Short courses and mini courses do not have this requirement with the exception of the Mushroom Course. To ensure that students are truly learning and processing information, we do not provide early access to units in the foundational courses and Mushroom Course so students will not be able to access all unit PDFs at once.

Do I need to attend class at a specific time?

No. Our courses are self-paced, which means that they fit into busy lifestyles! There are no required live lectures and students have access to their courses 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.

This means that students who have busy schedules or do not live near an herb school will find that the Herbal Academy offers a great way to get a solid herbal education that fits with their life.

Note that all courses have expiration dates which are triggered when the student clicks the Start Course button. We strive to give students more than enough time to complete their studies with the regular demands of life factored in. For example, students have 1 year to complete the Introductory Herbal Course, however most students finish the course in 4 to 6 months.

Extensions are available if course access time runs out before the student has finished their course.

Will I have access to teachers?

We are here for you and we want to hear from you! If you have questions about course content or herbalism, our team of experienced and clinical herbalists is just an email away! Teachers respond with in-depth answers and when applicable, helpful links to further student research and learning. Our team is here to assist Monday through Friday.

If you need or want a highly flexible schedule, want to learn from the comfort of your own home, and are able to be self-motivated, then Herbal Academy is a great option for you.

With the freedom and flexibility of a modern online classroom, you have the ability to engage in our courses on your own schedule – may that be late nights after your children go to sleep, daytime hours between your college courses, or on weekends in your time off work!

With this independence, students are able to self-motivate and set their own schedules. While our courses offer lots of wonderful recipes and exercises to help you get hands on with herbs, as well as some video content, most of the content is presented in written form.

When is the Herbal Academy not the best fit?

If you are looking for a teacher you can spend time with and interact with directly on a daily basis, then the Herbal Academy may not be the best fit for you. Specifically, students who are looking for one-on-one mentorship, direct instruction, or frequent contact with teachers will not find this at the Herbal Academy. We do not offer daily instruction via the internet or a schedule for you to follow like a traditional classroom setting does.

While our course platform is very user-friendly, you will need to be able to function well online or be willing to learn this skill! Our team is here to help you make yourself at home in your courses and we have helped thousands of students of all technology skill levels to enjoy the online platform.

Course content is mostly presented in written form and so students must be able to read to learn and take multiple choice quizzes to work through their studies. Note that quizzes are essentially open book and can be taken over and over until the required score of 80% is achieved. Advanced Course students are also required to complete additional exercises and a monograph project in order to receive their certificate of completion.

We do not offer mentorships for students who are working toward gaining hands-on clinical experience however we do offer ideas for setting up mentorship in the Advanced Course.

The Entrepreneur Course does not cover requirements for setting up an herbal business that are specific to individual states or countries. Students looking for this information will be best served to do their own independent research.

We are here for students who need support! We want to help, and we love hearing from our students! Because we are an online school with a small administrative staff, we can best assist students via email. If you want to talk with someone, we can help with that in a limited capacity—we are not able to offer phone conversations as a main form of support.

Guidance for Specific Questions and Situations

Do you offer courses in languages other than English?

Note that our courses are mostly text-based and in English only. You will find videos in our courses along with the written text as well as lovely graphics and pictures. We help students to get hands-on with their studies through suggested exercises to complete and plenty of recipes to try. However, you will need to be able to read and listen to English.

It is possible to use a translator if English is not your first language, and it is important to note some scientific terminology might not translate directly.

I am differently abled, can I still take your courses?

Most of our course content is available in written format however we do have some videos in our courses. For students with hearing difficulties, we offer transcripts of the video content available as downloadable PDFs for most of our courses. We do not have subtitle capability at this time, however we are looking into adding this feature.

Students with sight difficulties may be able to use a screen reader to access written content in the course.

Are Herbal Academy courses applicable to students studying outside of the United States?

Our classroom is truly a global classroom. We are honored to have students joining us in class from around the world. Herbal Academy courses offer a wide range of information about plants, herbs, and the business of herbalism, depending on the course you choose. Much of the information on plants and herbs will be applicable outside of the United States.

Our courses cover the basic concepts of Western herbalism that can be applied to the various different herbs found worldwide. We do also cover herbs from all over the world in our courses including many herbs that are used as culinary herbs such as ginger, turmeric, rosemary, basil, cayenne, cinnamon, black pepper, and more that are typically readily available globally. Through your learning with us you will develop the tools you need to study any herbs beyond what is covered in the courses. So if there is a plant local to you that is not covered in the course, you will have the knowledge you need through our courses to research and study that plant!

Special note about the Entrepreneur Herbal Course:

For international students who are interested in taking the Entrepreneur Herbal Course, note that there are 34 lessons total in the Entrepreneur Herbal Course and all of them are applicable to our students who wish to start a business making herbal products regardless of location. This is with the exception of two lessons, one which covers Labeling Herbal Products and one that covers Good Manufacturing Processes. These two lessons are written with the U.S. Food and Drug Administration guidelines in mind. Within these two lessons you will find a lot of good information about manufacturing and labeling in general, however you will need to keep in mind the requirements in your location may be different and thus you will need to research those independently.

I have previous experience in herbalism, what course should I choose? Do I need to start with the Introductory Herbal Course or can I jump right into a course more suited to my skill level?

We have herbalists from all backgrounds and experience levels joining us in class. You can start at the level that best suits your needs. We find that most students with previous experience are best able to determine the appropriate course for them by visiting the detailed course outlines available on each foundational course page. I am vegan, will I be able to make the recipes in the courses?

Our courses offer some general ideas for substitutions in the courses (for example in the Botanical Skin Care Course we discuss vegan wax substitutes for beeswax), but we don't give specific measurements for vegan substitutes in specific recipes.

When choosing a substitution, you will want to be mindful of what the original ingredient is doing in the recipe. For example, many herbalists do prize honey for its own benefits in recipes beyond preservation and taste.

Herbalists who do not wish to or cannot use honey can substitute maple syrup, vegetable glycerin, and sugar depending on the preparation. For example, glycerin and sugar can be used in place of honey for syrup making, while date syrup and maple syrup can be used in place of honey for making herbal honeys and oxymels. Please do note that maple syrup and date syrup will not offer the same preservation benefits as honey.

As you work through the courses you will also find that some of our recipes use beeswax. Substitutes for beeswax include sunflower wax, candelilla wax, and soy wax. Research the pros and cons of each of these waxes, including sustainability concerns. You can also look into using emulsifying wax, however this is a synthetic product and so we recommend that our students do research on this product before using.
